CME Requirements At-A-Glance	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial based on last name (p.10)</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 50 Category 1 CME – 30 in licensee’s area of specialty every two-year renewal cycle</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 Controlled Substances/Prescribing
State-Mandated CME Content Detail	<p>Physicians who have prescribed, administered, or dispensed any controlled substance pursuant to a West Virginia license in the two-year license cycle preceding renewal, are required to complete 3-hours of Board-approved CME in drug diversion training and best practice prescribing of controlled substances training during each reporting period.</p>
