
Standard 5.3: Sentinel Node Biopsy for Breast Cancer

Operation

For all nodal staging operations performed with **curative intent** for patients with breast cancers of epithelial origin

Remove nodes that are:

- Radioactive
- Dye stained
- Present at the end of dye-filled lymphatic channel
- Palpably suspicious
- Clipped



All sentinel nodes must be identified, removed, and subjected to pathologic analysis.

Documentation

Required elements/ responses in synoptic format

- ✓ Curative intent
- √ Tracer(s) used
- ✓ Upfront or neoadjuvant setting
- ✓ Removal of all sentinel nodes
- ✓ Removal of all clipped nodes (if applicable)
