

TEAM Impact Analysis

New England Census Division

The table below provides an estimate of the TEAM Financial Impact using qualifying 2023 Medicare FFS cases from hospitals mandated to participate in TEAM within the states indicated. The table includes the total case count by TEAM episode, as well as the case count and average financial impact by revenue "winners" vs "losers."

The modeling shows that more episodes will come in below the modeled target price than above, but the losses on high-cost cases are likely to outweigh the gains from less expensive cases.
